

Terrence Richburg

A native Washingtonian talent renowned for his God-given musicianship, from an early age multi-instrumentalist and vocalist, Terrence Richburg has amazed audiences with his adaptable, authenticated style and "smooth" delivery. Richburg is an accomplished recording artist with a wealth of knowledge of all musical styles and genres, as well as the music industry. He has performed throughout the country and is characterized by his peers as "The Quincy Jones of Gospel," "a musician's musician," and "a producer's producer." Terrence chronicles a vast musical history in the Gospel, Jazz, and Gospel-Jazz communities, having worked with such notables as Richard Smallwood & Vision, Maurette Brown Clark, Vanessa R. Williams, Marcus Johnson, Alyson Williams, Cee Cee Michaela, Yolanda Adams, Kim Jordan, Jeremiah Murphy, Aretha Franklin, The Winans, Jennifer Holliday, Tramaine Hawkins, Walter Hawkins, Isaiah Thomas, James Cleveland, Shirley Caesar, Ben Tankard, Bobby Lyle, Nick Colionne, Phillip "Doc" Martin, Spur of The Moment, and many others.

Son of John & Wilhelmina Richburg, known as Atlantic recording artists, The Richburg Singers, and nephew of jazz legend and co-founded the East Coast Jazz Festival, Ronnie Wells, Richburg is a prolific composer, lyricist, writer, poet, vocalist, arranger, orchestrator, producer, director, pianist, keyboardist, electric and acoustic guitarist, percussionist, 4/5/6/7-string bassist, recording engineer, and the list goes on. Terrence has written, produced and performed musical soundtracks for videos, theme songs and music beds for radio stations, and jingles for major corporations, including D.C.'s WYCB and Heaven 1580, as well as Marriott. He has served as Musician/MD for theater and musical productions including "Lord I'm Coming Home," "Dream Girls," "The Wiz," "Ain't Misbehavin!" "Wait 'Til the Fat Lady Sings," "God's Trombones," "City at Peace," "Where Eagles Fly, " and other events such as the Washington Performing Arts, music award shows, AIDS and Cancer fundraisers, benefits for "Katrina" and "Tsunami" victims, and many other prestigious events. He has enjoyed much success with his Gospel Jazz group, R&R, with the release of their debut CD, Ascension, featuring Howard Riley, Jr. on saxophone and Terrence on 7-String bass, vocals, and all other instruments. In 2007, R&R opened for GRAMMY Award winner CeCe Winans. Richburg's later group, Terrence Richburg & The Experience, generated wide acclaim featuring Terrence in his element on bass, guitar, keyboards, and vocals, as the Spirit leads—an amazing one-man duet on bass and keys simultaneously.

In 2010 he dropped a Christmas single entitled "In One Night" featuring his wife, renowned songstress Kathy Richburg, and has blazed the stage with such incredible jazz greats as Gerald Albright, Steve Cole, and The Marcus Mitchell Project. Terrence's 7-string bass talents are featured on CD releases by Robert Person – Soul Sanctuary (2011), and Kim Jordan – Uncommon (2012). Richburg was also honored by The DC Area Musicians Fellowship and presented the very first annual 2013 Treble Cleft Award for his extensive achievements in Gospel music and church music ministry.



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In 2014, Richburg was commissioned Prince Georges Community College to write the music for and record their brand-new school song, Victorious. Terrence further served as MD and ministered with Praise & Worship recording artist, Shannon Wexelberg, for the ACSI-NEXUS conference and world-wide broadcast hosted at Woodstream Church in 2014 and 2015. Richburg also teamed up with long-time friend, Jazz Saxophonist, Phil French, to record and produce their 1st full CD project together, Everlasting... featuring Terrence Richburg, which was released under his RichEscape Music label in January 2015. The album features an array of original songs and arrangements by Terrence, along with his prolific performance on all other instrumentation, instrumental solos, and vocal leads and background vocals. Everlasting received rave reviews and was featured on Smooth jazz radio stations all over the world. Industry icons Ben Tankard, Jean Carne, Norman Connors, and Steven Ford all offered glowing reviews of the album, which received five 2016 Rhythm of Gospel Award nominations, a 30th Annual 2016 Washington Area Music Award (WAMMIE) nomination and

artists as Carolyn Malichi and Rare Essence at the "Music at the Monument" concert series at the Sylvan Theatre and Carter Barron in Washington, DC in support of veterans, post-traumatic stress disorder treatment, youth development, and theatre renovation programs.

In the world of literature, Terrence is a gifted poet and freelance writer having written reviews and articles for many renown online magazines and publications, including his own online E-zine publication, JazzGospelCentral.com. Richburg's debut book release, Intimacy: Missing "Peace" in the Puzzle of True Love & Close Relationships, was featured in the 2013 Frankfurt, Germany and Guadalajara, Mexico International Book Fairs and the 2014 Book Expo America in New York.

Terrence's most recent works include unprecedented simultaneous 2018 releases of a brand new literary work, Soul of a Poet's Heart – Gallery of Poetry, Prose & Songs, and three new solo artist CD releases, including Gospel project, RichSpirit ONE – (Silver Anniversary Recording Release), Gospel Jazz project, Beyond Measure and Inspirational Jazz/Gospel R&B project, Portrait of Adoration. The two latter projects were accepted for consideration in multiple album and song award categories for the Recording Academy's 61st Grammy Awards. Terrence was also a 2019 Best Jazz Album Wammie Awards Nominee Finalist for Portrait of Adoration, which is featured on Music Choice and Smooth Jazz stations globally.

Although he's proud of his label RichEscape Music, securing a 2009 Stellar Award Nomination and many other achievements, Terrence proclaims accepting Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Savior his most significant life accomplishment. Terrence performs locally and nationally and ministers at several churches in the DMV area including his home church, Israel Metropolitan CME Church in Washington, DC.

Owner of Stellar Award-Nominated Record Label & Popular Gospel Jazz Musician, Terrence Richburg, Steps Out As A Solo Artist with Three Music Projects Dropping On June 29, 2018

Artist Also To Simultaneously Release New Book & Sophomore Writing, Soul of A Poet's Heart

(Washington, DC) – June 8, 2018 – Many people know Terrence Richburg as a Gospel jazz musician and producer. As a Gospel jazz artist, he's performed as R&R (with saxophonist Howard E. Riley, Jr.) and The Terrence Richburg Experience. As a multi-instrumentalist, musical director and producer, he's worked with top artists including Richard Smallwood & Vision, Maurette Brown Clark, Vanessa R. Williams, Tramaine Hawkins, Shirley Caesar, Volanda Adams, Ben Tankard, Gerald Albright, Jennifer Holliday, The Winans, and late gospel icons Walter Hawkins and Rev. James Cleveland. A background vocalist, engineer, arranger, songwriter, minister of music and record label owner as well, he caught the attention of the Stellar Awards when praise and worship artist Terrell Hunt received a Stellar Award nomination for his project, Awesome, in 2009, an album released on Richburg's own RichEscape Music record label. Now Richburg is stepping out from behind the scenes to center stage with an incredible set of new releases: three albums – RichSpirit One, Beyond Measure and Portrait of Adoration – and his sophomore writing, Soul of A Poet's Heart. All four will release on June 29, 2018.

For this momentous occasion, Terrence Richburg will celebrate all four releases at a CD/Book Release Celebration that will take place on Friday, June 29, 2018 at 6:30PM at his church, Woodstream Church, 9800 Lottsford Road, Mitchellville, MD. The free event will feature performances by Richburg and an opportunity to purchase the book and three CDs. The projects will be available for purchase online on iTunes, Amazon and other digital retailers on Monday, July 2, 2018. Soul of A Poet's Heart will be available later this month in all major bookstores and online book outlets.

The inspiration for the slew of simultaneous new releases came when Richburg realized how many great musicians and artists are leaving us. "I came to the conclusion that many artists were passing away at an early age – some without having completed all that they wanted to do or were meant to do," shares Terrence. "I want to make sure that everything God has poured into me I'm able to share with the world."

The prolific artist, who has been featured on numerous artists' projects, has been in the music industry for decades. His parents, John and Wilhelmina Richburg, along with his uncle Julius Richburg, were known as the Richburg Singers and were signed to Atlantic Records and his aunt was world-renowned, jazz legend Ronnie Wells. With music in his blood, one of his upcoming releases, Rich Spirit One, was actually produced 25 years ago. The project, which shows a very different side of the artist, was initially created as background music for an exercise video. Unfortunately, the video was never widely released, but it left Richburg with timeless, up-tempo music to add to his repertoire. He decided to release it as the solo Gospel album, Rich Spirit One.

Portrait of Adoration, the second musical release, had unique origins as well. "Portrait of Adoration initially started as tunes I wrote and produced to serve as musical beds to accompany spoken word poetry," he recounts. "My vision was that the music would complement poetry readings and enhance verbal intensity, which is a characteristic feature of the spoken word culture," he says. But after working with the new music, he found that the songs could stand on their own as an album.

Beyond Measure is a CD that's releasing on June 29th as well. The project differentiates itself from the other two in that it is a musical collage of all of the artist's gifts. "Beyond Measure showcases much of the talent that God has given me," says Richburg. "It's a glimpse of all the things that God has done in me instrumentally and vocally, and as a composer/arranger." The project also flaunts the artist's musical diversity. He has a song on the project that has a commanding Latin jazz, big band flair and additional tracks that deliver a variety of sounds and styles. Richburg is also playing all the instrumentation and doing most of the singing himself on this and the other albums, with a few very special guest exceptions. He says that the project will present a side of him that few have heard. He says, "As an artist I'm presenting – for the first time – a different type of performing and writing that I feel is pretty exciting".

Music isn't the only gift that Richburg is showcasing with his upcoming releases. He's also releasing his second book called "Soul of A Poet's Heart". He has been writing poetry for years, but just made the decision to introduce his writings to the world. He says, "I started writing 'Soul of A Poet's Heart' in the 90s. My life went through some twists and turns during that time and it made me reflect on life. I was dealing with work issues as well as still grieving the loss of my father. Writing was therapeutic for me and helped me to deal with the major life changes I was going through at the time. But it also helped me to capture some pretty amazing life lessons and valuable wisdom I gained from all my experiences."
